

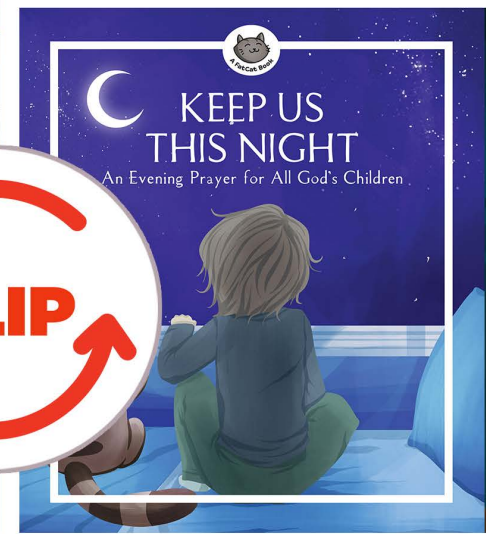
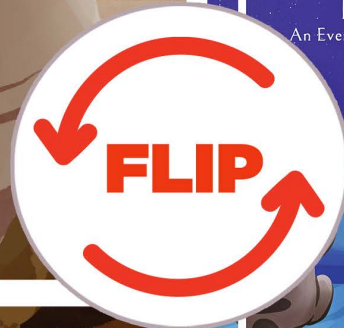


KEEP US THIS DAY

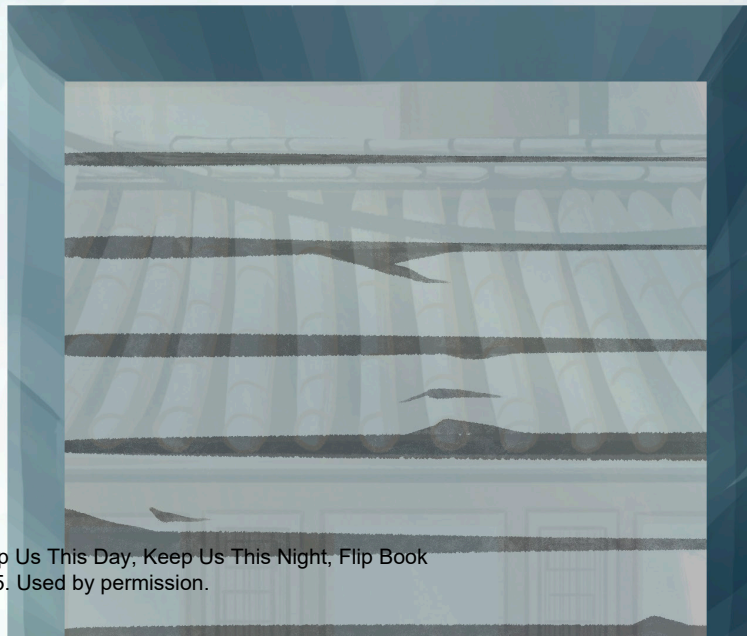
